**Position Summary:** This is a part-time, seasonal position responsible for supporting the SGT program by providing a safe, nurturing and successful experience for all the students in the program for the classroom, production and choreography components of the SGT season for the Musical Theatre Program. Weekly on-site attendance is expected throughout the program duration. Season dates vary by program site.

**Reporting Relationships:** Reports directly to the Program/Educational Manager.

## Major Responsibilities:

- Assist SGT teaching staff with implementing lesson plan activities
- Provide behavioral support to individual students as indicated
- Learn the story of the selected production, as well as all choreography and lyrics.
- Provide assistance with blocking, entrances and exits, and off stage activities, along with other aspects of selected SGT production.
- Support Teacher, ProductionManager and Choreographer during their sessions by assisting with activity and managing student behavior.
- Help students with achieving success in their selected part in the production, assisting with creating adaptations as needed.
- Maintain communication with the SGT team via email between classes.
- Attend all weekly classes, extended dress rehearsals and final performances.

## Skills and Qualifications:

- 2-4 years of work experience with individuals with disabilities, theater, or related field
- Bachelor's Degree or Associate's Degree from an accredited institution in Theater,
   Special Education, or a similar field preferred
- Self-motivated individual who is able to multitask
- Excellent verbal, written, organizational and time management skills
- Access to technology to use for planning, management and communications including Google applications.
- Basic knowledge of theater/production elements is helpful, but not required.
- Strong teamwork and interpersonal skills.
- A heart for individuals with disabilities and their families and believes in the mission of Special Gifts Theatre.
